

Delphian Chorale

The Delphian Chorale is a choir comprised of soprano/alto and tenor/bass singers from grades 11 and 12, with select 10th graders being chosen by audition only. This group performs a variety of music covering many genres throughout the school year. Performance requirements for this ensemble are the Alma Mater at home football games, community performances in November and December, the Christmas Concert in December, Singing Valentines in February, the March concert, and Concert in the Park in May. Uniforms for this group are as follows for boys:
Black tux jacket, red vest and bow tie, tux pants, and tux shirt (provided by the school)
Black shoes, black socks (provided by the student)

For girls:
Red and black floor length dress (provided by the school)
Black shoes (provided by the student)

Gender neutral uniform offered to anyone who prefers to wear it.

All Delphian students will be provided two polo shirts which must be returned at the end of their time in Delphian Chorale. The students will purchase a Delphian Chorale t-shirt to be worn at football games, which will remain their property.
